Dear Parent/Guardians and Students,

We are excited to announce that the Viking Marching Band has accepted an invitation to travel to Hawaii in June of 2020. The band will be performing in the King Kamehameha Floral Celebration Parade and at Pearl Harbor in the presence of the USS Missouri. This trip and these performances are truly once in a lifetime opportunities. The Viking Marching Band has performed at these venues in 2011 and 2015, and is widely acknowledged as one of the most meaningful trips our students have taken at North High.

Please review all the information in this packet. By signing the commitment letter you and your student agree to participate in the Hawaii Trip and agree to pay all costs listed herein. The total amount of payments will be approximately **\$2400.00** per student. We will also be in need of chaperones for this trip. We will offer a Friends and Family Trip that will accommodate other parents and families at the appropriate room rate. (Fewer in a room the higher the price)

Students must be enrolled in Band in order to be eligible to go on the trip, including graduated 2020 seniors. Grades and class citizenship may affect student eligibility. Because of our federal not-for-profit status, under no circumstances may fund raised money be returned to a student. If balances are not paid by the due dates the student may be dropped from the trip and you will still be responsible for the balance.

Trip payments: are nonrefundable for any reason. This is a music department policy that has been in effect for many years. You may sell your trip to a qualifying band member.
